ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

The London Queer Fringe Festival is a vibrant celebration of LGBTQ+ voices and humor, showcasing a diverse array of talent from both emerging and established comedians. Set against the backdrop of one of the world's most dynamic cities, the festival offers a platform for performers to explore and share their unique experiences, challenging stereotypes and pushing boundaries through laughter. With a lineup featuring everything from stand-up and sketch comedy to improv and drama, the festival fosters an inclusive atmosphere that invites audiences to embrace the power of performance in promoting understanding and connection within the queer community and beyond.



PROGRAMMING

We are looking for a wide range of performance, if you have a show that you would like to bring to the festival then please get in touch.

You do not need to be LGBTQ+ - you simply need to believe that your show would appeal to an LGBTQ+ audience, If in doubt about this please do get in touch with us.

Your show can be a 'finished' show or a work in progress but if it is a WIP it should be identified as such.



THE DEAL

Registration Fee

This is the fee you pay to register your show with the festival and it is based on the number of performances you choose to do.

Number of Performances	Registration Fee
1	£40 + VAT
2	£60 + VAT
3	£70 + VAT
4	£80 + VAT

Venue Rental Fee

Our deal is a 70/30 ticket revenue split in your favour with a minimum guarantee to the venue of £50 **except for Saturday slots after 5pm where the minimum guarantee is £100.**

You can set any ticket price you want but we recommend keeping it below £15.

Both your registration fee and your minimum guarantee are due at the point of registering your show. your minimum guarantee will be taken off any balance owing at the end of the festival based on ticket sales.

ALL PRICES QUOTED ARE PLUS VAT. SETTLEMENT WILL BE MADE WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE END OF THE FESTIVAL.

MARKETING

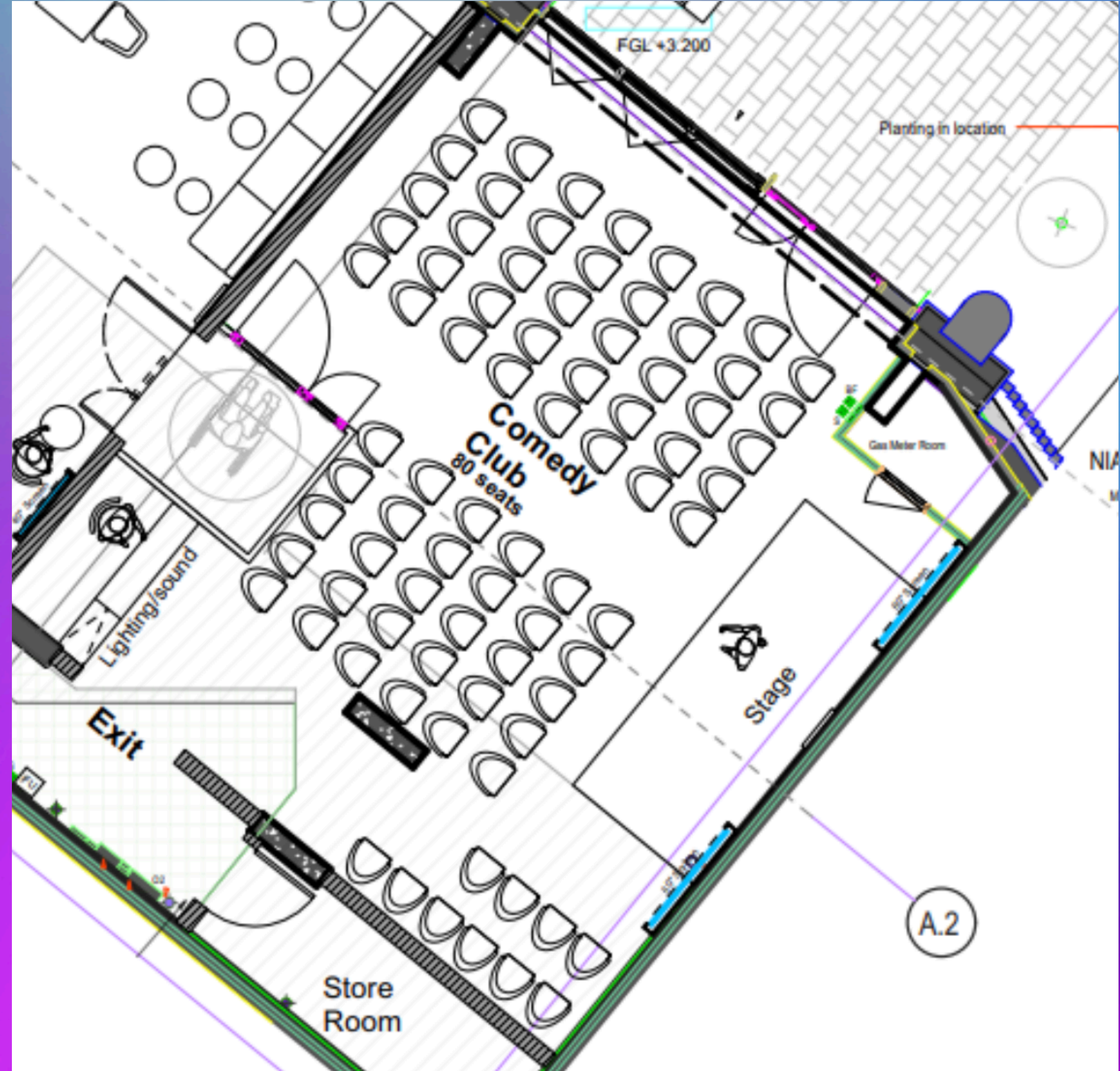
The festival will be promoted throughout London with an extensive media and PR campaign, via our website, social media and mailing list. There will be additional on site advertising options available for an additional charge which will be released at a later date.

We will be offering a **Festival Pass** allowing unlimited access to all shows at the festival. If an attendee books for your show using the Festival Pass then you will be credited with an equivalent ticket sale of £2, regardless of your set ticket price. You will automatically be opted into this promotion but if you would like to opt out please contact us.



OUR NEW VENUE

In 2025 we are launching our brand new, purpose built performance space, located in our sister venue, Betty & Joan's. This new venue is in a prominent position on Elephant Park, located in Zone 1. This new venue includes a 30% increase in capacity, improved tech set up and a stage more than twice the size of our original venue.



OUR VENUE

STAGE

Our professional stage is approximately 4.2m x 1.8m and about 30cm high.

LIGHTING

We have two lighting bars each with Spot 4 x high-power 8 W 4in1 QCL RGBW (homogenous color mix), Strobe effect 4 x high-power 1 W CW.

SOUND

PA system, sound inputs, two wired mics.

SEATING

80 seats, available in reduced flexible sections creating spaces of 70, 60, 50 and 40 seats in total.

MARKETING

Shows will be included on our website and in our social media posts as well as included in our what's on mailing list. Tickets must be sold via our box office. **You are responsible for the marketing of your show.**

OUR VENUE

VISUAL

We have two 60 inch TVs positioned to the side of the stage, these have hdmi inputs accessed via the tech desk at the back of the room. Please note there is an additional charge for use of these, please contact us for details.

BAR

There is a bar on site with a late licence and an outside terrace area that is open until 10pm during the summer months

ACCESS

The venue is fully accessible and all on one level. Seats can be removed to allow wheelchair access, please note this will impact capacity.

TRAVEL

We are located 3 minutes walk from either Elephant & Castle tube & overground stations.

GET IN / OUT

The standard arrangement is for a 30 minute get in/get out which may be shared with the show before/after you.
